<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Students writing responses to worksheet questions- Student seating arranged in such a way to allow all students to see the board and the teacher	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Students read worksheet and answer questions- Students answer questions orally during discussions
Cognitive Development	Self-Concept, Identity, and Motivation
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Teacher reviews chicken wing dissection procedures the day before the experiment to ensure understanding	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Teacher provides immediate feedback as students work- “Good Urgency” comments from teacher encourages students to remain on task- Positive Reinforcement used instead of punishment
Peer Relations and Moral Development	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Students seated in pairs to encourage partner work- Students use hand signals to encourage one another
