So what?

Zy'Sean's responses align very well with the development of a typical nine year old, according to Wood's *Yardsticks*. He is well-coordinated, evidenced by his strong soccer skills at recess, and he pushes physical limits. He tires easily (often sleeps in class) and struggles to sit for long. He always tries to get the rocking chair when he walks into the classroom so he can move throughout the day. He is intellectually curious and is always asking questions about things he hears, sees, and reads. Zy'Sean loves using technology to express his ideas and creativity, which is very typical for a nine year old. He is a student in my own classroom, so I have noticed exaggerated expressions when hurt, typically on the soccer field, which is typical developmentally. Zy'Sean is very self-critical, and this is also evidenced in his response to if he feels nervous throughout the day. He is enrolled in co-located mental health services, which allow him to work through managing his emotions with a mental health counselor.
